

Citation Management Tools Comparison: Organizing & Collaborating

Zotero, Mendeley and Endnote all provide four basic functions: capturing, organizing, citing, and sharing references.

The major differences between these tools are their organization and collaboration features compared in **Table 1 & Table 2** below.
